Dear Chris,


Since you are coming to Hong Kong at Christmas, I want to give you some suggestions that where you should go.

First, I want to introduce some fun places for you. The Peak is a good place for sightseeing. The place there is beautiful. You can also go hiking there.



You should go to Mong Kok to shop since you can buy a lot of things and you can buy the souvenirs to your family. Mong Kok is a very lively place.






Our School Picnic


we ate happily.


Finally, we arrived and we found a good place to have our picnic. We played Monopoly first.

After a while, Tommy won the game and got carried away. Next, we played hide-and-seek.


Ken got hurt and we all felt upset for him.

After a while, the teacher told us it was the time to leave. Therefore, we left happily since we had a good memory here.








The School Picnic

Yesterday, I went on a school picnic. We went to Ma On Shan Country Park for picnic. All the schoolmates looked forward to our picnic for a long time.




Last week, we went to Lion Rock Country Park with our schoolmates for our school picnic.



At one fifteen, we left the country park by school bus. I fell asleep on the school bus. Therefore, I took a nap. I think it is an unforgettable trip.







When we arrived at the park, we were pleased.


First, Alex found an excellent and well place.

There were many picnic tables. We could have lunch in there. Every classmates' lunches were rich, such as sushi, sandwiches, chicken wings and so on.


Then, everyone was full. After that, we played the hide-and-seek. We were thrilled and pleased.
